
Affidavit
As to the Factual History of A Meeting at Englewood Hospital in 1979

In 1979, I, Irving Gerdik, MD, was serving the United States Olympic Committee as Chairman of Sport Medicine, when I was called by Dr. Stephen Press at my office, then in Englewood, NJ. These are the facts as I recall them of what subsequently transpired:

- I.- Sometime in 1979, through suggestion of Dr. Ib Theisen, Dr. Press called me, and we spoke on the phone. A meeting consisting of myself, and Drs. Stephen Press and Leonard Schroeder (the ACA Sports Council President), was arranged at Englewood Hospital cafeteria for a couple of weeks hence.
- II.- At that meeting it was arranged that I would meet with Dr. Joe Janek at National College in Lombard, IL, on my way to Colorado Springs.
- III.- Drs. Leonard Schroeder and William Womer picked me up at O'Hare Airport, and I arrived National College with Dr. Janek.
- IV.- Fully impressed, I proceeded to a meeting of the USOC Sports Medicine Council at Colorado Springs, where it was my recommendation despite some opposition, to go to the to the full committee, where we got a unanimous vote to evaluate adding a DC to the team.
- V.- On my return, I called Dr. Press and asked him "do you want me go?". He demurred, due to his then only one year's practical experience, I then asked him for a recommendation, and Dr. Press gave me Dr. George Goodheart's name and number.
- VI.- I told Dr. Press that I was grateful for his honesty, and promised to start a program for the DC's like USOC had for MDs, i.e., a two week volunteer doctor program, and that he would be the first DC to go to Colorado Springs for it.
- VII.- We then invited George Goodheart to come to Colorado Springs, where he demonstrated his professional skills and competence over several visits to the training center. We were once again impressed, and decided to take him to Lake Placid. Thus George Goodheart became the first DC to attend the Olympic Games with the US team at the XIIIth Winter Olympic Games in Lake Placid, in 1980.

The rest is Chiropractic History.
